

Newquay Cricket Club 2013 - 100 Club Rules

1. The object of the 100 Club is to raise funds for Newquay Cricket Club.
2. The 100 Club will be administered by the Cricket Club Management Committee.
3. The 100 Club is open to all. Members must be over 16 years of age.
4. Entry will be by subscription of £20 per year per number, paid in advance. Payments by Direct Debit may be made annually (£20) or quarterly (£5). Payments by cash or cheque will be accepted on payment of £20 to cover an entire year.
5. Members may have more than one number.
6. There shall be a maximum of 100 numbers available (1-100). New members will be admitted when numbers become available. If all 100 numbers are allocated, a waiting list will be kept and numbers offered in order of application.
7. A monthly draw will take place during the Management Committee meeting.
8. The monthly prize money will be 50% of the monthly income. There will be two prizes per month. The amounts of such prizes will be decided by the Management Committee.
9. Only the numbers of paid up members will be entered in the monthly draw. All such numbers will be included. Members are required to give one month's notice of withdrawal from the scheme.
10. Winners will be advised by the Treasurer and a cheque for the appropriate amount will be sent to the participant's address.
11. A register will be kept recording the names and addresses of each member, the number(s) allocated to them and the subscriptions received from them.
12. The Management Committee reserves the right to alter the rules of the 100 Club as necessary. Participants will be notified of changes.
13. The Management Committee reserves the right to wind up the 100 Club at any time, and will repay any payments made in advance.
